- 3. Scholarship(s) may be awarded at the discretion of the KC SHRM board
- 4. Application must be completed in full, with all supporting documentation attached at time of submission.
- 5. All criteria are subject to consideration upon review and verification by the KC SHRM board.
- 6. KC SHRM reserves the right to deny any candidate at its discretion.
- 7. You will not be eligible for an award if you have received an award in the past two years.
- 8. APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY AUGUST 5, 2020, DEADLINE.

The recommendations should come from any of the following: Employer/supervisor, human resource professionals, or professors/faculty members. Contact information including full name, phone number, and email must be provided. Family and KCSHRM Board members may not be used for recommendation/reference.

2. ESSAY: Write an essay no longer than two (2) pages in length (double-spaced, size 12 font) discussing the reasons why you should receive a KC SHRM scholarship. This essay should include the dollar amount of scholarship you wish to receive and your accomplishments and experience as it relates to human resources.

3. RESUME: A copy of your most recent resume

4. ATTACH (if applicable): Verification of enrollment in a HR certification or course, or registration for a HR certification exam. Applicants who provide verification will be given preference in scholarship amount awarded.
